He also shared that every three years we are required to have a Capital Reserve Plan and that he only comment that was shared was that we should be putting more \$\$ into the reserve fund.

We again shared that the monthly HOA dues will increase by 10% starting in January 2026 and that there will be a onetime special assessment in January 2026 to cover the balance of the Master Liability insurance premium covering June 2025-June 2026.

- E. Brian opened it up for questions:
- Again, we had questions regarding the water that runs between our properties and the golf course. Since this belongs to the golf course we do not feel like we can do much about it. Also, a question of rusty light cans on the exterior of our homes and there was a question as to whether to paint or replace. Also, the rust on the sheet metal beneath the siding on our homes.
